



## 16 -19 Tuition Fund 2021-2022 Academic Year

### What is the 16-19 Tuition Fund?

The 16-19 tuition fund was first provided for the 2020-2021 academic year and is being extended beyond 2021-22 for a further two years. It is ring fenced funding for schools, colleges and all other 16-19 providers to mitigate the disruption to learning arising from the coronavirus pandemic (COVID-19). The funding is being provided to support tuition for 16- to 19-year-old students.

### Who can be supported by this fund?

Support will be prioritised for students who have met our entry criteria but have not achieved a grade 4 in GCSE English language or maths. Learners may also be selected for support on the basis that they have not achieved grade 5 or above in GCSE English language and/or maths or are from an economically disadvantaged background and would need catch-up support. All supported students must be on a 16 to 19 study programme.

### How will Cheltenham Bournside School be using the fund?

At Cheltenham Bournside School, we will be using the tuition funds provided to us to give Sixth Form learners tailored support in one-to-one and small group settings, as part of their 16-19 full programmes of study. Eligible students will receive 4 hours tuition in Mathematics and/or English language across a full two-week cycle of our timetable. Our students will be in one-to-one or small group settings and will receive bespoke tuition based on need for GCSE mathematics or English language. Specifically, this will focus on the tutor supporting the students to address any gaps in knowledge or skills, any misconceptions that have been identified through the tuition sessions and any development that is needed in examination technique/revision.

This programme will commence during the week beginning 1 November 2021 and will run through to the commencement of the summer examinations in 2022.
