
# Additional language GCSE - Year 10

# Request for support: Please help us to improve road safety on Warden Hill Road



We are pleased to share a <u>new proposal</u> to install two permanent zebra crossings outside of the school on Warden Hill Road to further improve road safety for our students; we would like to request the support of our school community.

Despite a series of improvements already being made in response to road safety concerns in Summer 2022, we have continued to work closely with local County, Borough and Parish Councillors to further improve the road safety measures, which we feel to date, have been inadequate and unclear to both pedestrians and motorists.

The new proposal addresses parental concerns to provide better crossing facilities with two permanent zebra crossings installed near both entrances to the school, alongside changes to the pavement layout. For the first time, these measures would impose a statutory duty on motorists to give way to pedestrians wishing to cross the road.

Have your say: A public consultation is currently underway and it is important that clear support for the project is demonstrated. Therefore, please show your support of the proposed crossings by emailing <a href="mailto:highwayconsult@gloucestershire.gov.uk">highwayconsult@gloucestershire.gov.uk</a> (quoting reference CB80408) marking your email for the attention of the Assistant Director of Legal Services. Even a brief one-line email in support of the project will make a difference. The consultation ends on **2 February 2024**. Thank you for your support.
