Over the summer a number of our students had great success with their sporting activities outside school. Nine of our students travelled



with their Club, Cheltenham Harriers, as they competed in the UK Youth Development League National Final in Manchester on 2nd September. This is the culmination of the League Competition which starts in May with 166 Teams from across England, Wales and Scotland taking part. Cheltenham were one of just 7 teams to qualify for the final. The Club placed 6th on the day.

Congratulations to the nine students who were selected to compete (Fred Parry, Sam Jeenes, Izzy Cook, Lottie Cook, Lexie Wiggett, Paige Wiggett, Lucas West, Jack Johnson and Rhys Haines), and to the individual medal winners: Fred (3 medals), Sam, Lucas and Jack. Lottie was also part of the relay team that set a new age group Club record – the previous one having stood for 14 years.
