## **Year 10 to 13 - The NHS Allied Work Experience Programme**

This is available for years 10-13 students to participate. You can register using the link below:

All students will be awarded a Work Experience Certificate for participating in the day. An excellent addition to their UCAS and Apprenticeship Applications.

The next Work Experience day is on Sunday 2nd October and will cover the following healthcare careers:

- Nursing
- Midwifery
- Paramedicine
- Physiotherapy
- Occupational Therapy
- Dietetics
- Radiography
- Prosthetics and Orthotics
- Speech and Language Therapy
- Pharmacy

The virtual work experience day will take place through an online portal and run LIVE from 10am-5pm, following 2 patients from their initial accidents through to recovery. Students will see them interact with a variety of healthcare professionals listed above so that they develop an understanding of the multidisciplinary team as well as insights into their own chosen careers.

Students will also have the opportunity to interact with healthcare professionals via a LIVE Chat function and polls throughout the day!

The cost to attend is £10/student per session, which is just an administrative cost to cover the set-up of individual portals, personalised certificates, safeguarding, and the technology on the day, such as our servers and chat functions – please contact school if this charge would stop your son/daughter participating.
