- ✓ **Branded Bournside Sixth Form v-neck jumper** – Compulsory for all students
- ✓ **Branded Bournside Sixth Form trousers (black)** or continue to use Bournside Year 11 trousers
- ✓ **Branded Bournside Sixth Form skirt** (in the following options)
 - a. Tartan branded Bournside pleated skirt
 - b. Plain navy branded Bournside skirt
- ✓ **Branded Bournside Sixth Form house tie** – Compulsory for Boys
- ✓ **White formal collared shirt** – Compulsory for Boys
- ✓ **White formal collared shirt and Sixth Form house tie OR white reverse collar blouse** - Girls
- ✓ **Branded Bournside Sixth Form blazer** – Optional
- ✓ **Black or brown formal low-heeled shoes** (below the ankle)
- ✓ **Black/navy/dark grey plain tights**

Jewellery, make up, and hairstyles

- ✓ Hairstyles must be neat and tidy

- ✓ Hair should not be excessively short or cut with lines or patterns.
